Amendments to the terms and conditions

Any matters not specifically covered by these terms and conditions shall be subject solely to the decision of the organiser. These terms and conditions may be amended at any time by the organiser and all amendments shall be binding on sponsors and exhibitors equally with the foregoing regulations.

Communication

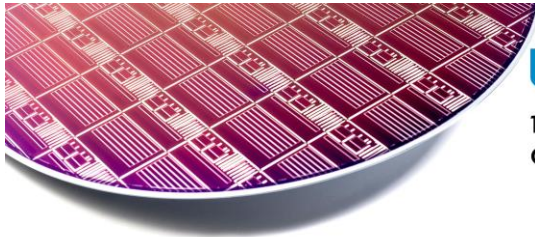

Payment conditions

Payment is due within 2 weeks from invoice date. All outstanding fees must be paid before the start of the Symposium and access cannot be guaranteed in case of non-payment.

Payment by credit card will be charged an extra 2.5% of the amount due to cover credit card Charges and these payments are processed via Stripe.

The Provider accepts payment by American Express, Visa, MasterCard and Maestro. If you choose to pay with a credit card, the money is immediately withdrawn from your card upon confirmation of payment.

Cancellation policy

Full reimbursement can be requested upon written cancellation by the participant within 14 days after purchase. 75% of the registration fee may be refunded upon written cancellation before 15 July 2023. Payment is non-refundable as from 16th July 2023 but a name can be substituted until 1 September 2023.

If the Symposium has to be cancelled by the organisers, Laurea Group BV's liability is limited to a full refund of the registration fee only. We will not refund travel or hotel costs associated.

Laurea Group BV accepts no liability if the Symposium is cancelled or postponed for reasons beyond our reasonable control resulting from an act of nature, governmental regulation, fire, war, terrorist activity or civil commotion and no refund can be claimed.

However, in case the Symposium cannot be organised on the set date a new date can be proposed as soon as reasonably can be expected. In that case, the organisers will aim to reschedule the Symposium within the next 12 months and no refunds can be claimed.

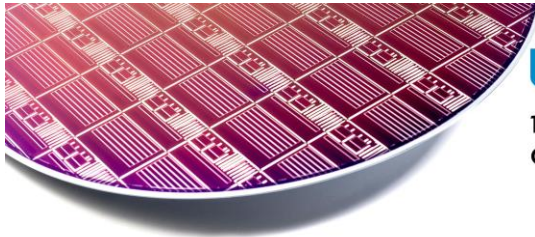
Complaint
